

## Can you help?

As we move closer to opening up our church life again, with more services and more activities taking place, there is a need for help to do this.

Here is a list of activities where support from the congregation would be very helpful. **Please note that all of the roles require only a small amount of time and effort and most can be carried out on a fixed occasional basis (e.g. on a monthly rota).**

- Lead prayers at services
- Additional readers for services
- Stewards – to open church, prepare for a service and welcome people as they arrive. Assistance needed particularly Sunday mornings but also for Wednesday morning and Sunday evening services as well
- Assist as a Steward at baptisms
- Gardening maintenance (for flower beds in the churchyard)
- Counting and banking of collections
- Prepare weekly notices
- Copy service papers, including reading sheet
- Preparation of refreshments after services
- Help at Natter Group meetings
