

A few Words on the Readings and other resources 13-09-2020

Genesis 50:15-21 Joseph's brothers bitterly regret their action against him. As predicted in Joseph's dream they fall down before him. Joseph assures them that God can turn round evil into good and gives them his full forgiveness.

Romans 14:1-12 The Christian community in Rome included Jews who still observed tradition and those who had abandoned it. There was friction between the two groups and Paul calls for mutual acceptance. We are only answerable to God and are not to judge each other.

Matthew 18:21-35 Having spoken about conflict resolution Jesus now points the way to unlimited forgiveness. He tells a parable about debts to show that an offence against our neighbour is like a debt. Forgiveness frees the debtor. God has forgiven us through Jesus's sacrifice on the cross and we are therefore bound to forgive.
