

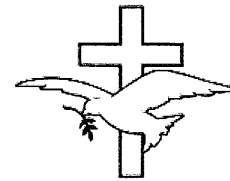

General Notices

Poppy Cascade

At Whiston Church we are planning, as part of our commemoration of the end of the First World War in 1918, to have a cascade of poppies inside Church. This will require hundreds of poppies, so we are appealing to the people of Whiston to knit some. Below is a very simple knitting pattern which is quick and easy to follow. We would be very grateful for your help. Poppies can be brought up to church or collected from your home. Please ring Jan Teale on 01709 820535 should you need assistance.



EASY KNITTED POPPY: *Size 3.75mm knitting needles (the bigger the needles, the bigger the poppy)*

Body of poppy: using red double knitting wool cast on 77 stitches. Knit 10 rows garter stitch. Row 11 – knit 2 together across the row. Thread the wool through the remaining stitches, pull together and sew the ends.
Centre of poppy: sew on a black button or embroider a black centre.
